Acrylic Brushes – Princeton Brush Set # 9153 set of six Short-handled Golden Taklon brushes: three rounds (Size 1,6,12), one ¾ inch wash, one ½ inch angle shader and one liner (size 2)
Acrylic Paint – Liquitex Or Golden Preferred, Either a starter Kit (or see color notes below)
Acrylic Medium Matte Liquid not Gel
Blue Painter's Tape
Drawing Board, Large Enough to Hold Bristol Paper
Gesso, 8 Ounces
Palette (see notes below)
Palette Knife
Paper – Strathmore Bristol Pad, 11 x 14 inches or 11 x 14 Stretched Canvas – Any Brand

Paint Suggestions - Liquitex or Golden Artist's Acrylic Tube Paints

- Cadmium Red Light
- Alizarin Crimson OR Acra Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- French Ultramarine Blue (or Ultramarine Blue)
- Cerulean Blue
- Phthalo Green
- Titanium White
- Yellow Oxide or Yellow Ochre
- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Mars Black

Palette -- you can use a clean Styrofoam tray from the grocery store, or a shallow pan or tray made of plastic, metal or ceramic, or wax paper taped to a table. Or if your budget permits, a Masterson Sta-Wet Palette.
