Juror and Judge Brenda Swenson

Brenda Swenson is a highly sought-after exhibition juror and judge, an acclaimed workshop instructor and the artist author of two books, *Keeping a Watercolor Sketchbook* (Finalist, Award of Excellence) and *Steps to Success in Watercolor*. Her artwork has been featured in countless books and magazines (*Splash, Best of Watercolor, An Illustrated Journey, Creative Freedom, Complete Guide to Watercolor, Watercolor Artist, Watercolor Magazine, Watercolor Highlights, Plein Air magazine* and numerous other publications), and she has achieved signature status in WW-M, NWWS, SDWS and CWA. An active participant in the arts community, Brenda has served on the Boards of Directors for the National Watercolor Society and Watercolor West.

Taxation: US residents for tax purposes who receive \$600 or more in awards and/or sales must complete a Form W-9 and will receive a Form 1099 in January 2024. US residents will be paid via check.

Entrants who are not US residents for tax purposes must complete a Form W-8 BEN (which will be emailed with instructions for completion). Withholding tax will be made from awards in accordance with US tax laws and any existing tax treaty with the entrant's country of residence. Due to tax withholding, awards will be cash awards only and not gift certificates. No withholding is required on proceeds of a sold painting that was painted outside of the US. Payments to non-US residents will be made via wire transfer.

Signature and Elite Signature Status

Signature status and Elite Signature status are honorifics awarded to artists whose works have been selected for multiple years' participation in the WAS-H IWE. Signature artists have exhibited their work in three IWEs; Elite Signature artists have exhibited their work in five or more IWEs. Once designated, artists may add the credential "WAS-H" after their signature to indicate their status.

To be eligible, an artist must be a WAS-H member at the time their works are accepted into the IWEs, however, there is no requirement for an artist to retain ongoing membership in WAS-H. A "Signature Status Artist" retains that honorific for life regardless of membership.

HOW TO ENTER

WAS-H uses CallforEntry.org (CaFE) to manage this Exhibition, and all entries are submitted online via CaFE. To enter, artists must have a CaFE profile, which is easy to create online. Once a profile is set up, artists can upload their artwork as digital files and enter the 2023 IWE Call-for-Entry.

Artwork must remain on display in the Gallery for the duration of the Exhibition. Removal of artwork prior to the closing will result in penalties assessed by the Board of Directors of WAS-H and disqualification to enter future shows.

Submitting a work of art to this Exhibition shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to comply fully with the conditions and terms set forth in this Prospectus.
